

# mantilla doily

Intermediate

Doily measures approximately 17" in diameter.

Size 10 Thread: 400 Yards White.

Steel Crochet Hook: 1.5mm [US 7].

**GAUGE: Rnds 1-8 = 4" across. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.**

Ch 5; join with a sl st to form a ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, 8 sc in ring; join with a sl st to first sc.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 3, 3 dc in same sc as joining, drop lp from hook, insert hook in top of ch-3 and into dropped lp, draw lp through the ch-3 – **beg popcorn (beg pc)** made; ch 4; \* 4 dc in next sc, drop lp from hook, insert hook in first of 4 dc and into dropped lp, draw lp through the dc – **pc** made; ch 4; rep from \* around; join to beg pc – 8 pc.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 1, \* (sc, ch 4, sc) all in ch-4 sp; rep from \* around; join to first sc.

**Rnd 4:** Sl st in sp, ch 4, (dc, [ch 1, dc] 3 times) all in same sp, \* (dc, [ch 1, dc] 4 times) all in next sp; rep from \* around; join to 3rd ch of ch-4.

**Rnd 5:** Ch 1, \* sc in ch-1 sp, ch 3; rep from \* around; join.

**Rnd 6:** Sl st in sp; ch 2, holding back last lp on hook, 2 dc in sp, yo and through all 3 lps on hook – **beg cl** made; \* ch 3, sc in next sp, ch 3 \*\*; holding back last lp on hook, 3 dc in next sp, yo and through all 4 lps on hook – **3-dc-cl** made; rep from \* around, end at \*\*; join to top of beg cl – 16 cl.

**Rnd 7:** Ch 1, \* sc in next sp, ch 4, sc in next sp \*\*, ch 2; rep from \* to last sp, end at \*\*; hdc in first sc to join and form last ch-2 sp.

**Rnd 8:** Ch 3, (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) all over hdc, \* 2 sc in ch-4 sp \*\*, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) all in ch-2 sp – **shell** made; rep from \* around, end at \*\*; join to top of ch-3.

**Rnd 9:** Sl st in next dc, ch 1, \* sc in sp, ch 7; rep from \* around; join.

**Rnd 10:** Sl st in next sp, ch 1, \* (sc, [ch 3, sc] 3 times) all in ch-7 sp; rep from \* around; join.

**Rnd 11:** Sl st in next sp, ch 1, \* sc in sp, ch 3; holding back last lp on hook, 2 dc in next sp, yo and through all 3 lps on hook – **2-dc-cl** made; ch 3, sc in next sp, ch 3; rep from \* around; join.

**Rnd 12:** Sl st in next sp, ch 1, \* sc in sp, ch 10, sc in next sp, ch 3, sc in next sp \*\*, ch 3; rep from \* around, end at \*\*; dc in first sc to join and form last ch-3 sp.

**Rnd 13:** Ch 1, \* (3-dc-cl, [ch 3, 3-dc-cl] 5 times) all in next ch-10 lp \*\*, [sc in next sp] twice; rep from \* to last sp, end at \*\*; sc in last sp; join to dc of Rnd 12.

**Rnd 14:** Sl st in next sp, ch 1, \* sc in sp, ch 3, [2 sc in next sp, ch 3] 3 times, sc in next sp; rep from \* around; join.

**Rnd 15:** Sl st in next sp, ch 1, \* sc in sp, ch 5, [2 sc in next sp, ch 5] twice, sc in next sp; rep from \* around; join.

**Rnd 16:** Sl st in next sp, ch 1, \* (sc, ch 4, sc) all in sp, [ch 4, (sc, ch 4, sc) all in next sp] twice; rep from \* around; join.

**Rnd 17:** Sl st in next sp, ch 1, \* 2 sc in sp, 3 sc in next sp, 5 sc in next sp, 3 sc in next sp, 2 sc in next sp; rep from \* around; join.

**Rnd 18:** Sl st in next 6 sc, ch 1, \* sc in next sc, ch 15, skip 14 sc; rep from \* around; join to first sc.

**Rnd 19:** (Ch 3, dc, ch 2, 2 dc) all in same sc as joining – **beg shell** made; \* (6 sc, ch 3, 6 sc) all in next lp \*\*, shell in next sc; rep from \* around, end at \*\*; join to top of ch-3.

**Rnd 20:** Sl st in next dc and into sp, beg shell in same sp – **rnd started**; \* ch 2, skip next 2 sc, sc in next 2 sc, (dc, [ch 1, dc] 5 times) all in ch-3 sp, skip next 2 sc, sc in next 2 sc, ch 2 \*\*; shell in next ch-2 sp – **shell over shell** made; rep from \* around, end at \*\*; join to top of ch-3.

**Rnd 21:** Start rnd, \* ch 3, sc in next sp, [2-dc-cl in next ch-1 sp, ch 3] 4 times, 2-dc-cl in next ch-1 sp, sc in next sp, ch 3 \*\*, shell over shell; rep from \* around, end at \*\*; join.

**Rnd 22:** Start rnd, (ch 2, 2 dc) all in same sp as beg shell, \* ch 3, sc in next sp, [(sc, ch 3, sc) all in next sp] 4 times, sc in next sp, ch 3 \*\*, (shell, ch 2, 2 dc) all in next ch-2 sp; rep from \* around, end at \*\*; join.

**Rnd 23:** Start rnd, \* ch 3, shell in next ch-2 sp, ch 3, [sc in next sp] twice, [ch 5, sc in next sp] 3 times, sc in next sp, ch 3 \*\*, shell in next ch-2 sp; rep from \* around, end at \*\*; join.

**Rnd 24:** Start rnd, \*\* (2-dc-cl, ch 5, 2-dc-cl) all in next sp, shell over shell, ch 3, [sc in next sp] twice, \* (dc, [ch 1, dc] twice) all in next sc, sc in next sp; rep from \* once more, sc in next sp, ch 3 \*\*; shell over shell; rep from \*\* around, end at \*\*; join.

**Rnd 25:** Start rnd, \* (tr, [ch 2, tr] 4 times) all in next ch-5 sp, shell over shell, ch 3, sc in next sp, skip next dc, sc in next dc, skip next dc, (dc, [ch 1, dc] 4 times) all in next sc, skip next dc, sc in next dc, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3 \*\*, shell over shell; rep from \* around, end at \*\*; join.

**Rnd 26:** Start rnd, ch 3, [(sc, ch 3, sc) all in next ch-2 sp] 4 times, ch 3, shell over shell, ch 3, sc in next sp, skip next ch-1 sp, sc in next dc, sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, skip next dc, sc in next ch-1 sp, sc in next dc, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3 \*\*, shell over shell; rep from \* around, end at \*\*; join.

**Rnd 27:** Sl st in next dc and into sp, ch 2, dc in sp, \* ch 3, 2 sc in next ch-3 sp, [4 dc in next sp] 4 times, 2 sc in next sp, ch 3, 2-dc-cl in next sp; holding back last lp on hook, tr in next 3 sps, yo and through all 4 lps on hook – **split cl** made \*\*; 2-dc-cl in next ch-2 sp; rep from \* around, end at \*\*; join to first dc.

**Rnd 28:** Ch 1, \* 2 sc in next sp, dc in next dc, [ch 1, dc in next dc] 15 times, 2 sc in next sp; ch 5; rep from \* around; join.

**Rnd 29:** Sl st in next 2 sts, ch 1, \* sc in next ch-1 sp, [(dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc) all in next sp, sc in next sp] 7 times, (2 sc, ch 2, 2 dc) all in next ch-5 sp; rep from \* around; join. Fasten off Weave in ends.

**ABBREVIATIONS:** ch = chain; dc = double crochet; lp(s) = loop(s); mm = millimeters; rep = repeat; rnd = round; sc = single crochet; sl st = slip stitch; sp(s) = space(s); tr = treble crochet; y = yarn over; \* or \*\* = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated; [] = work directions given in brackets the number of times specified.
